Delta Dental of Virginia's Smile Ambassadors group continues to guide the company's efforts around philanthropy, volunteerism and environmental stewardship. Below is a summary of the community accomplishments led by our Smile Ambassadors and carried out by our team members.

- Delta Dental of Virginia team members gave 14 units of blood, supporting the lives of 42 patients.
- Provided 7,000 bamboo toothbrushes to include in 3,500 Ready Bags for families who experience unexpected hospital stays after their child receives a cancer diagnosis.
- Completed four ROC Solid Foundation playground builds for children diagnosed with cancer. 60 team members, ten guests and seven repeat builders participated. 50% of the Smile Ambassadors participated in at least one build.

- 96 team members pledged to reduce their carbon footprint in celebration of Earth Day.
- We more than doubled the use of volunteer time from 241 volunteer hours in 2021 to 651 in 2022, and from 42 unique individuals to 101 unique individuals.
- Team members raised \$500 for the American Heart Association Heart Walk when they organized a team and also sponsored the walk with an additional \$5,000.
- 15 team members hosted a Bingo game with the veterans at the Virginia Veteran Care Center, providing fellowship, snacks and prizes.
- Collected 30 bags of trash for Clean Valley Day.
- Eleven team members volunteered at the Little Feet Meet for Special Olympics.
- Launched Smile Tank, a friendly competition among team members designed to highlight non-profits in which our employees play a role.
 The winner of the competition gets \$5,000 for the non-profit they nominated.
- Donated \$20,000 to non-profits focused on food insecurity across the Commonwealth.

- In partnership with Carilion Clinic and Freedom First, team members collected 2,000 pounds of food for a Back to School Food Drive.
- Collected \$2,400 from team members for food banks in the Commonwealth.
- In partnership with Carilion Clinic and Freedom First, we collected food to provide 100 Thanksgiving meals for low-income families.
- Provided \$4500 for school supplies and other basic needs for students at Fallon Park Elementary School.
- Packed 200 Holiday Care gift bags for shelter guests staying at The Roanoke Rescue Mission, including toothbrushes and other hygiene items.
